

PRAAYER PARTNERS

Pick a partner close to you. Share a prayer request and find scriptures upon which to build your case before God. Find at least 3 scriptures to back up what you're asking. Then, pray together, based on the Word, about your need.

Suggested Reading: 1 John 5:14-15, John 16:24

YOUR WILL BE DONE

Jesus prayed the “prayer of consecration” in the garden before going to the cross. In essence, he was lining up his life with God’s plan. This is the only type of prayer where you should pray, “if it’s your will.” Spend a few moments praying about your life and aligning yourself with God’s purposes and plans for you. Talk to God about the next steps He has for you and what He might need you to do to get in position. End by confirming your decision to submit to God’s will for your life.

Suggested Scriptures: Matthew 26:39

COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS

**There's an old hymn that contains the lyrics
"Count your blessings, name them one by one.
Count your many blessings, see what God has
done."**

**Take a few moments and list on one of the papers
below at least 5 blessings you've received from God
in the last month or so. Let this list be a catalyst
for giving thanks to God.**

COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS

COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS

A.C.T.S

One particular model for prayer uses this acronym:

Adoration - give God praise for who He is

Confession - speak the Word

Thanksgiving - thank God for what He's done

Supplication - ask God for what you need

Go through these steps in the next few moments as you spend time in private prayer.

Suggested Scriptures: Hebrews 4:14, Ephesians 5:20

TONGUE TALKING

One of the most wonderful gifts God has given us as Spirit-filled believers is the ability to pray in unknown languages. Take this time to pray in the Spirit knowing that the Holy Spirit is praying through you the perfect will of God.

Ask God to give you the interpretation of what you're praying so you can be further edified through your understanding.

Suggested Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 14:14-15 AMP, Romans 8:26

PRAYER JOURNAL

One unique way to pray is to write out your prayers or list your needs specifically. This is particularly inspiring when God answers and you can check off the thing on your list. It's a great reminder of His faithfulness to us.

Use your own notebook or a piece of paper below to do this. Be sure to share your testimony with us after you're able to check something off your list.

Suggested Scriptures: Philippians 4:19, 2 Corinthians 9:8

PRAAYER EXPLOSION

This is a time to pray for the lost. We don't pray that God would save the lost people in our lives because He's already sent Jesus to save them. We pray for laborers to come across their paths to proclaim the good news to them and that they are open and receptive to the gospel. We command the blinders to be removed from the eyes of their hearts. We then commit ourselves to BE the laborers and proclaim the good news to others. Use these statements as a model for your prayers for the lost.

Suggested Scriptures: 1 Timothy 2:3-4, Matthew 9:35-38
